
Thanks Girls School Troop 1165!



The students of Hickory will be educated in the coming weeks on the purpose and use of the Buddy Benches at special assemblies given by Girl Scout Troop 1165.



The Buddy Bench idea was proposed to Mrs. Groves by Girl Scout Troop 1165 as a part of their Silver Award project. The Silver Award is the second highest award in Girl Scouting and the educational presentation is the culmination of over 50 hours of service dedicated to their project *Make New Friends*, which included supporting newly arrived refugee families from Burma and the Democratic Republic of the Congo, providing needed items to migrant farm workers in the southern part of our county and entertaining senior citizens at Westminster Woods.
