

From the School Nurse:

As we near the end of the school year, I would like to remind you to stop by the clinic to pick up your child's medication. School policy does not allow for medication to remain in the school over the summer. It will be important for you to make arrangements to pick up your child's medication since medications may not go home with the student. Any medication left in the clinic after Tuesday, May 28th at 11:00 AM will be discarded.

As you know, medication orders must be completed every school year whether your child remains in the same school or goes to another St. Johns County School. If your child has a physical examination during the summer months, this is a good time to get the medication forms completed.

For your convenience, the clinic will be open beginning Wednesday, August 7th to accept your child's medication and completed medication forms.
