Parking in Nearby Communities

Please do not park in communities close to our campus and then walk to our campus. This affects the traffic in surrounding communities. Specifically the community of Greenbrier. Residents have concerns regarding parents parking on Fox Hunt Trail then crossing over to our campus. Our car line has become more efficient, please drive through to pick up your student. In addition, please reach out to Donna Gary-Donovan for bus route information.

Home Access Center (HAC)

<u>Home Access Center</u> (HAC) allows students and parents to view their child's educational information via a secure, password protected website, Android app, or iPhone app.

Please familiarize yourself with HAC. HAC is where you can track your student's grades/progress and access information such as Schoology access codes, bus transportation, state testing data, district testing data, and attendance.

Absences

A <u>written note</u> is needed within 48 hours of returning to school stating the cause of the absence.

<u>Excused absences include</u>: personal illness, illness of an immediate family member, a death in the family, religious holidays of the student's established religious faith, required court or law agency appearances, public functions, state competitions, scheduled doctor or dentist appointments.

<u>Unexcused absences include</u>: shopping trips, pleasure trips, suspension from school, appointments without prior approval except in case of emergency, truancy, and other avoidable absences.

For a complete list of excused and unexcused absences, refer to the <u>Student Code of Conduct</u>.

Arrival

Parents will not be able to walk students in the building. We will continue to have several staff members and safety patrols stationed all along the entrances and hallways to assist our students. All students should have received a backpack tag to place on their backpack at the Meet Your Teacher event. The tag states their name, grade, and teacher's name. This tag should remain on your child's backpack all year. If you did not receive one, please email your child's teacher. Our arrival car line is running very efficiently and ends at 8:25AM. If you arrive after this time, you MUST park your car and check your child in at the front office.



Dismissal

Currently our dismissal app is not ready for use. We will email information THIS WEEK regarding access and directions for the app/website when all student information has been uploaded to their database. If you are a returning parent, please DELETE the app. The company has created a new app, but the old one MUST be deleted.

Please make sure to have your car tag visible during car line dismissal. *Please keep these tags on your rear-view mirror until your student is loaded.* If you ever forget your car tag, you will need to park, and we will need to verify ID before releasing your student.

To access bus information please log on to <u>HAC</u>. If you do not see bus information on your child's profile, please contact Donna Gary-Donovan to see if your child qualifies for bus transportation.

<u>Please note</u> we will not release students for early dismissal after 2PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday; after 1pm on Wednesdays.
