SSYRA Grades 3-5 Book List

Students can earn brag tags for each of the current SSYRA books that they read. They simply need to read one of the books (paper copy, eBook, audiobook, class read-aloud, etc...) and then take our 10-question quiz on the book to show evidence they've read the book. *A perfect score is not necessary.*

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Home Access Center (HAC)

Please make sure you have access to HAC.
Interim progress reports will be issued on **September 14 by 4PM.**
HAC is the system we will use to share your child's progress.

Home Access Center (HAC) allows students and parents to view their child's educational information via a secure, password protected website, Android app, or iPhone app.

Please familiarize yourself with HAC. HAC is where you can track your student's grades/progress and access information such as Schoology access codes, bus transportation, state testing data, district testing data, and attendance.

Absences

A [written note](#) is needed within 48 hours of returning to school stating the cause of the absence.

Excused absences include: personal illness, illness of an immediate family member, a death in the family, religious holidays of the student's established religious faith, required court or law agency appearances, public functions, state competitions, scheduled doctor or dentist appointments.

Unexcused absences include: shopping trips, pleasure trips, suspension from school, appointments without prior approval except in case of emergency, truancy, and other avoidable absences.

Morning Arrival

For the safety of our patrols and adults during morning arrival, please do not pull out of the car line to move ahead an unloading vehicle. In addition, drivers should be off their cell phone. Please move cautiously as you approach the crosswalk, our students may stop a vehicle to help someone cross.



Dismissal



Currently the school is on the market for a new company regarding the dismissal app. School Dismissal Manager/Fastlane has been offline and not functional for a while. Thank you for your patience during this change.

Please make sure to have your car tag visible during car line dismissal. Please keep these tags on your rear-view mirror until your student is loaded. If you ever forget your car tag, you will need to park, and we will need to verify ID before releasing your student.

To access bus information please log on to HAC. If you do not see bus information on your child's profile, please contact Donna Gary-Donovan to see if your child qualifies for bus transportation.

Please note we will not release students for early dismissal after 2PM on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday; after 1pm on Wednesdays.
