GLOW PARTY INFORMATION

Last day to return the permission slip is Wednesday, April 27.

On Friday, April 29th your student will come home with a bracelet. Please keep the bracelet on, as this will be re-entry to school for the party. The dance will be chaperoned by several teachers. We will dismiss all students from the car line side. Please have your child's name visible on the dashboard or rear-view mirror of your vehicle for quick dismissal.

UPDATED COVID-19 Information

Please review the SJCSD protocols found at <u>https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/covid-19/</u>. In addition, please take time to review the <u>Student Health Screening Entry Form</u>. Should your child have any of the symptoms listed, please consider keeping them home. While masks are not mandated, it is an option for our families and staff. We will respect each other's choice. If you are interested in desk shields for your child, please contact your child's teacher directly.

The Department of Health updated their emergency rule (64DER21-15) to include instruction student quarantines.

- 1. Student quarantines: (3)(a) Parents or legal guardians of students who are known to have been in direct contact with an individual who received a positive diagnostic test for COVID-19 may choose one of the following options:
 - a. 1. Allow the student to attend school, school-sponsored activities, or be on school property, without restrictions or disparate treatment, so long as the student remains asymptomatic; or
 - b. 2. Quarantine the student for a period of time not to exceed five days from the date of last direct contact with an individual that is positive for COVID-19.

To notify us of your child's positive COVID-19 test result we are requesting that you complete the <u>Optional Positive Student Reporting Form</u>. However, should you feel you need to discuss your child's COVID-19 scenario in detail, please feel free to bypass the form and <u>call the District COVID Support Team at 904-547-8230</u>.



When we receive information regarding a positive student, we will communicate to <u>all</u> parents in the classroom that there has been a positive case in your child's class. In the past, we have only communicated to close contacts. By making this adjustment, we can notify parents faster and more efficiently.
