What is SAC? \rightarrow The School Advisory Council is a state-mandated

organization that allows for school-based management and accountability. An improvement plan is developed each year, largely composed of defined areas of growth based on school data. NURSE AND CLINIC NEWS

If a child needs to take a prescribed medication during the school day, a parent or guardian must bring the original bottle of medication to the clinic with a completed "Authorization to Assist in the Administration of Medication/Treatment form" signed by a doctor. This form is also required for dispensing over the counter drugs such as

<u>ABSENCES</u>

A <u>written note</u> is needed within 48 hours of returning to school stating the cause of the absence.

Excused absences include personal illness, illness of an immediate family member, a death in the family, religious holidays of the student's established religious faith, required court or law agency appearances, public functions, state competitions, scheduled doctor or dentist appointments.
