



A.M. The run/walk will begin and end at Palencia Elementary School, located at 355 Palencia Village Drive, St. Augustine.

Walkers and runners will enjoy a course running through the neighborhoods of Kensington and Las Calinas and can choose to participate in the 6K (3.73 miles) or 3K (1.86 miles) distance.

Registration fees are as follows:

6K Walk/Run

\$30 before January 1 \$35 January 1 – February 2 \$40 on race day

3K Walk/Run

\$25 before January 1 \$30 January 1 – February 2 \$35 on race day

A <u>written note</u> is needed within 48 hours of returning to school stating the cause of the absence.

Unexcused absences include: shopping trips, pleasure trips**, suspension from school, appointments without prior approval except in case of emergency, truancy, and other avoidable absences.

ILLNess and Prevention Guidelines

As flu season approaches, it is very important to follow the <u>SJCSD illness and</u> <u>prevention guidelines</u>. Please do not send a student to school if the have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or greater
- Chills
- · General tiredness or not feeling good
- Frequent congested (wet) or croup-sounding cough
- · Lots of nasal congestion with frequent blowing of nose
- Vomiting (even just once)
- Diarrhea
- Stomach pain that is accompanied by repeated vomiting or diarrhea. Note: if you child complains of stomach pain for several days, you should call your doctor for advice.
- · Symptoms of cold or flu
