## ILLNess and Prevention Guidelines

Flu season is upon us, it is very important to follow the <u>SJCSD illness and prevention</u> <u>guidelines</u>. Please do not send a student to school if the have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever of 100.4 or greater
- Chills
- · General tiredness or not feeling good
- Frequent congested (wet) or croup-sounding cough
- Lots of nasal congestion with frequent blowing of nose
- Vomiting (even just once)
- Diarrhea
- Stomach pain that is accompanied by repeated vomiting or diarrhea. Note: if you child complains of stomach pain for several days, you should call your doctor for advice.
- · Symptoms of cold or flu


