Kindergarten Readiness

Many parents ask what their child needs to know before starting Kindergarten. What can parents do to help? The following skills, behaviors, and tasks will make for a successful transition.

Social and Listening

- Interacts well with other children and adults
- Takes turns, shares, and plays well with other children
- Talks with others to solve disagreement and works things out
- Follows simple 2-3 step directions
- Answers simple who, what, when, where questions
- Demonstrates self-control (raises hand, waits turn to speak, listens to a story)
- Handles their emotions appropriately

Literacy

- Recognizes name in print, writes first name correctly
- Recognizes letters and some sounds
- Holds a book correctly and can turn pages
- Shows interest in reading or being read to
- Can tell if 2 words rhyme such as cat and bat
- Begins to draw pictures to express ideas and tell stories

Math

- Identifies numbers 0-10 and attempts to write them
- Can point and count up to 10 digits
- Identifies basic 2D shapes
- Understands which number is more or less (numbers up to 10)
- Can sort a group of items by color, shape, or size

Other Skills

- Knows full name and names of parents
- Can tell own age and birthday
- Can put on, button or zip down clothing, jacket, and backpack
- Can use the restroom, wash hands, and blow nose independently
- Asks for help when needed
- Adjusts to new situations without parents being there

- Responds appropriately to redirection, own feelings and feelings of others
- Uses pencils, crayons, and scissors appropriately

Top 10 Things To Know

1. ANYONE who enters our building must apply and receive “volunteer clearance” through the SJCS D Keep’n’Track system. Go to <https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/volunteer/> and register immediately. Any person not cleared in the system will not be allowed to enter the building.
2. Stay informed via our weekly newsletter (sent through email every Friday), and by visiting our school website.
3. If you are not receiving communication from the school or your child’s teacher, please contact the school to verify that all contact information is correct in our system.
4. Report Cards are only distributed online through our Home Access Center (HAC). Please visit <https://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/hac/> to get signed up. Paper copies are available upon request. Student progress in grades 3-5 is visible to parents on HAC.
5. Check your child’s planner and backpack daily.
6. Join PTO, attend PTO functions, and become involved with our School Advisory Council (SAC).
7. Volunteering in your child’s classroom will be encouraged. We have many opportunities for parents to serve. Please make prearrangements with your child’s teacher for volunteer opportunities. Access will not be granted if you are not a cleared volunteer. In addition, access may be denied if the teacher is not aware of your attendance.
8. Edible birthday treats are allowed; however, treats must be pre-packaged. Please contact the teacher PRIOR to bringing treats. The teacher will communicate allergies in the classroom that may need an accommodation.
9. Please make appointments when wanting to conference with the teacher.
10. Please reach out to your child’s teacher or administration on how we can make this transition a smooth one for you and your child.

What is Kindergarten Staggered Start? Staggered Start provides an opportunity for the kindergarten teacher to work with a very small group of students each day. The teacher will teach rituals and routines and ensure students are comfortable with their environment before introducing them to the entire class. The teacher will also complete preliminary diagnostics and screenings to check for kindergarten readiness.

How does Staggered Start work? Kindergarten families will sign up at the Kindergarten Meet Your Teacher event for one day during the first week of school (August 12th-August 15th). The student only attends one day (their scheduled day) and then all kindergarten students attend on Friday, August 16th.

When will our family be assigned our Staggered Start date? For families to have the flexibility of the date for their student, families will sign up at the Kindergarten Meet Your Teacher event. The Kindergarten team and/or administration will not assign a date.

How will I know my child's teacher? Teachers will make contact with families via email and/or a phone call on or before August 7th.

How will I know my child's bus information? Once transportation has assigned routes families will be notified via postcard, email, and/or the information will be on the Home Access Center (HAC).

How can I volunteer? There are many ways to volunteer on our campus. Your student's teacher will have opportunities for volunteering. In addition, you can volunteer via PTO or the School Advisory Committee (SAC). All volunteers **MUST** be cleared through our [School Access Form](#).
