Nurse and Clinic News

If a child needs to take a prescribed medication during the school day, a parent or guardian must bring the <u>original bottle</u> of medication to the clinic with a completed "<u>Authorization to Assist in the Administration of Medication/Treatment form</u>" signed by a doctor.
